#### **AGENDA:**

**ELEVATOR AND OPTIONS:** Many technicians have been here to examine and work on the elevator; none were able to repair the elevator. Two technicians are coming soon to hopefully fix the issues with the elevator. Next steps: Building & Grounds committee will meet to address the next steps with the elevator.

**LOCK-IN & MOVIE NIGHT**: Friday, August 12 outdoor movie night featuring Disney's *Encanto!* Popcorn and water will be furnished. In conjunction with the movie, there will be a youth (grade 7-12) lock-in. This will be a good opportunity for youth and Pastor Bryce to meet.

**SUMMER PARTY REVIEW**: The summer party was held on Saturday, July 23. It was a good evening of fun and fellowship.

**KITCHEN UPDATE**: Many renovations are being considered for the kitchen.

**OFFERING PLATES**: It has been asked if we should continue to pass the offering plates. This will be discussed at the January, 2023 meeting.

**LABOR DAY:** We will have 2 services on Labor Day; Saturday at 5:00 and Sunday at 10:00.

**FOOD GIVEAWAY SIGNAGE:** At future food giveaways, we will have signage and information that tells who is giving the food away.

PASTOR UPDATES: Plans have begun for Fall Kick-Off which will be September 10 -11. Pastor Bryce will have a booth at LATC student orientation on Tuesday, August 16. Pastor Jen will start a new membership class. Dakotas Conference will be convening a special Annual Conference on Saturday,

November 19. The agenda will include one business item: consideration of resolutions ratifying the disaffiliation of local churches from the United Methodist Church.
