A Note from Pastor Jen,

While it doesn't look how we had hoped or planned because of the weather... the Christian season of Lent officially began last week, on Ash Wednesday (Feb 22). After consulting with other staff and the chair of our Leadership Team, we moved our Ash Wednesday worship to online only. Immediately upon making that decision, our staff quickly got to work recording prayers, music, sermons and more as we reflected with gratitude for all we learned about doing this well during COVID... and with perhaps greater gratitude still that this is something we don't have to do very often anymore.

My reflections on this experience didn't end with thinking about COVID, though, as much as I was struck by the beauty of our new series kicking off in this way. You see: our new sermon series that began on Ash Wednesday and will take us to Easter is titled, "Busy: Reconnecting with an Unhurried God." There's a bit of irony in the fact that even our usual midweek schedules have come to a halt as we start to talk about the importance of slowing down, and ceasing to be so busy... isn't there?

For many of us, the season of Lent has been a time when we think about "giving something up." The idea behind this is that we give up something that is an integral part of our lives, and during this season especially, we use that extra space or longing in our life to connect more with God. Unfortunately, the worldly culture around us has shifted how we think about this, often letting the thing we give up become about discipline or restriction or even (in the worst case scenarios) diet culture. Yet I wonder... what if we thought less about *giving up* – and more about *making room*?

Throughout this season, we are going to be talking about ways to *make room* for God in our lives in new, growing, intentional ways. We are going to focus on slowing down, in order to be more fully present in the spaces we find ourselves. This doesn't mean you have to give up things, activities, or commitments (though it absolutely can if you're overbooked or overwhelmed!). It *does* mean you are invited to connect to our unhurried God... to know that God is with you always, and to know that God is longing for you to find rest – physical, spiritual, and emotional – in him. After all, Jesus does promise us this when he says (in Matthew 11:28), "Come to me all you who are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, I will give you rest."

As we seek rest this season, may it not be rest for the sake of it so we can go back to running full speed on Easter Sunday. Rather, may we find rest that we can *lean into* throughout our lives: starting in this season, and always. Perhaps you will find that rest by spending time with God in quiet spaces throughout your day, by prioritizing worship with community, or by joining one of our Lent study groups as we seek to grow in faith by reading scripture together. Maybe you'll find rest by meditating, by cutting back on some of your commitments that are taking away your energy, or by trying to run a little less in what feels like your busy and chaotic life.

Whatever rest looks like for you in this season of your life: may you find it this season as we let go of being busy... and we find innovative ways to reconnect to our *Unhurried* God.

Let's shower Roosevelt with some love this month.

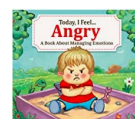
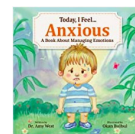

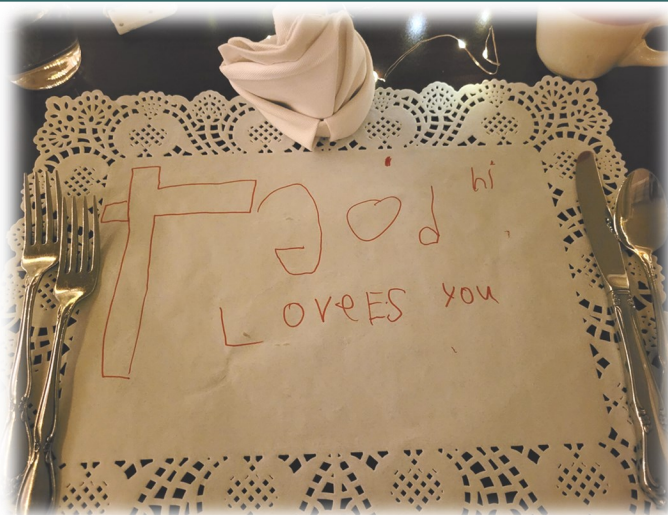
