

Nursery Care Provider

At First United Methodist Church, children are an essential part of our community. Our Nursery Care Providers help care for our youngest members (birth to age 5) by providing care for children in a safe, secure, nurturing, and Christ-centered environment. The nursery is open every weekend during worship (Saturdays 4:30pm-6:15pm and Sundays 9:30am-11:15am), Wednesday evenings (5:30pm-7:45pm), and other times as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience caring for children, and an ability to physically care for and play with infants and children.
- An ability to adapt and interact with a variety of persons including children, parents, and co-workers.
- Must be able to pass a background check.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide nurturing interactions for nursery children at all times scheduled to work.
- Interact with children through engaging and educational Christ-centered lessons, activities, and nurseryage programming. Primary concern is to be given to children's safety and welfare while exhibiting Christ-like patience and love.
- Assist with the cleanliness and condition of the Nursery Room and Cry Room, including monitoring condition and cleaning of toys.
- Follow all nursery policies, including First Church's Safe Sanctuaries policy.

Position is part time, paid \$14/hr. Flexibility in scheduling is possible, but consistency that offers the ability to grow in relationship and trust with our children and parents is essential.
