Welcome: Welcome Pastor Sara to our church and to Leadership Team.

Accessibility Team Update: Pastor Sara reported that she has received schematics from the architect. This project needs to be kept moving. Concerns are that the team has not met for some time. The chair has moved out of town.

Wall/Foundation in Cook Hall: The work will be done the week of August 19 – 23. B & G team needs to check to see what prep work needs to be done prior to the contractor beginning.

Dishwasher/Sink Repair Status: The double sink issue is being addressed by having Midwest Pipe repair the elbow where it seems that the blockage begins. The quote is for \$1150.00. At this time the dishwasher is working.

Building Usage: This spring at General Conference of UMC, it was approved for United Methodist clergy to perform same sex marriages. Our church needs to have a discussion and form a policy as to whether same sex marriages can be performed in our church building or on the church grounds. There will be 2 informational meetings to discuss this. The meetings will be following the worship services the weekend of August 24 & 25. Nursery will be provided for these meetings. Members of Watertown First United Methodist Church will then be asked to vote on this. Voting will take place in the lobby area of the east entrance on Wednesday. Pastor Bryce: Pastor Bryce was not able to be at the meeting as he is helping to lead a camp called Next Normal at Storm Mountain. He did send a report.

The youth mission trip to Storm Mountain went well.

The summer youth Bible study on the Gospel of Luke is going well. IMPACT, the young adult group, met on June 25 for a time of games and working out at the wellness Center. The next event is July 25; a grill out at the lake. A prayer request is for our search for a new Director of Music and Technology and for volunteers who are helping.

Pastor Sara: Pastor Sara just began her time at our church on July 1. She is getting to know people and going to small groups. She is also working on issues like our technology and staffing. The chaplain at Prairie Lakes Hospital gave her a tour. She has some conference duties that she will be attending in August.

Building & Grounds: The B & G items were discussed earlier.

Finance: April reported that giving is down. Adam oversees the investments. He will be asking Leadership Team members to complete a risk assessment. Because we are a church, we need to be responsible stewards of our investments.

SPR: Debbie reported that this has been a busy month with planning the going away for both Pastor Jen and Lucas and planning the welcome for Pastor Sara.

SPR met with Lucas and revised the job description and job title. This position has been posted. The church & clergy forms were submitted to the conference. SPR feels there needs to be written procedures for the variety of opportunities around the church. SPR also feels there needs to be an inventory of equipment, furniture, capital expenses, etc. The worship/music team met with Pastor Bryce. Technology volunteers are needed and training will be provided. We will have an opening for a nursery attendant. We are 2 members short on Leadership.

Ministry: Barb reported on the Mission of the Month. July's mission is the Banquet as we will serve it on August 12. August Mission of the Month will be Shoebox Christmas. The Diaper GiveAway will be August 5.

Meeting concluded with the *Breakthrough Prayer*.

One of the changes made at the most recent General Conference in Charlotte, NC included removing the restrictions on clergy officiating at LGBTQ+ weddings. As this has not been a part of our wedding policies here at First Church, the Leadership Team invites you to participate in informational conversations after worship on Saturday, August 24th and Sunday August 25th. All professing members of First Church are then invited to participate in a ballot-vote on August 28th on whether to include LGBTQ+ weddings as a part of our building use.
