Like the weather, sometimes it is tempting to try and hold on to what is behind us. We hold on to things that have happened in the past or the way that things used to be. We don't like to give up control or step into unknown life circumstances. Maybe you have felt this temptation before as you are faced with a new health challenge or the start of a new school year. Maybe you have felt this when starting a new job or moving to a new place. The reality of life is that we all face change.

The problem is that no matter how hard we try, we can't change the past and we also can't make the past, our future. The past gets left behind while we are forced to move forward. Wedding Policies Voting Results

Greetings First Church Family,

On Wednesday August 28th, we took a ballot-vote to decide whether to allow same-sex weddings to happen in the building or church property here in Watertown. I spent quite a lot of time this last week praying for the work of God in the midst of this vote and wondering how we as a congregation would do the work of Christ in the outcome.

After 12 hours of voting, 110 people coming in to the building to vote and help decide, our congregation responded with a clear answer: **we are divided on this issue.** The vote was exactly 55-55.

While this does not resolve any of our questions, it does give us a clear picture of what many of us had suspected. We are not a congregation of one mind. We sit and worship God together while disagreeing on many things and this makes us a stronger community for it. **We are united in Christ.**

As a leadership team, we honestly didn't plan for a tie vote and so I cannot give you a clear plan of what is next. But this I promise, the Leadership Team will continue to pray and discern what kind of conversations we will have and what steps we will take.

We did not make a decision this week, and so we sit in the in-between. Our policies will not change, neither allowing – nor denying same-sex weddings.

Please continue to pray for our congregation, and our leadership as we do the work of Christ together.

Devotion & Opening Prayer was given by Marcia Schneider.

April Geffre opened the meeting at 5:35 pm.

Accessibility Team Update: Pastor Sara reported trying to get the committee together.

Wall in Cook Hall: Peggy reported that Chris Marotz is still on schedule to start the repairs to the wall on 8/20/24. There is no preliminary work that has to be done before he arrives. She also reported that when Mid West Pipe was here fixing the sink issue the vibration of their machine caused a chunk of the plaster to fall out in the hall way. She asked Chris if he would fix this also. He will look at it when he gets there to start the repairs.

Dishwasher/Sink repair status: Pastor Sara reported the sink drain has been repaired. The garbage disposal will not be reinstalled. Redlinger Brothers will be here on Wednesday 8/14/24 to reinstall the sink.

Building Usage Discussion: Pastor Sara reported that she has a report that she will be giving for the town hall meeting after worship on 8/24 and 8/25. She will give a brief history on the decisions made at Annual Conference on LGBTQ+. She will go over our wedding policy as it is now.

Pastor Updates: Pastor Bryce reported we are now between seasons. He is currently planning for the upcoming year. He is still looking for volunteers to help with the youth groups.

Pastor Sara Updated that she will be leaving for vacation on Wednesday 8/14 and will return on Monday 8/19. Alayna Nelson was hired for the Worship and Technology position. She is doing really well adjusting to the position.

Leadership Team Group Updates

Building and Ground: Peggy reported she had spoken to Ernie Wight about the trimming of the trees that was brought up at the June Meeting. She reported that Ernie will touch base with Terry Jorgenson and do a drive by and see what needs to be trimmed. They usually do the trimming in the fall. He suggested if there are any able bodies that are willing to help with clean up after the trimming is done. Pastor Bryce and April both thought that the youth group would be able to help with that. Pastor Sara also mentioned that the second air conditioner unit in the Fellowship Hall has not worked for the last 2 years. It was installed in 1991. The bid for the replacement was \$14,765. Sue made a motion to request from the Foundation the money to replace the unit. April second the motion.

Finance: April reported that Pearl had told her there are 3 families that have stopped their ACH payments. One family has moved out of town, one family has gone to another church, and the third family will be paying by check. The treasure's report was presented.

Through July the giving is down \$22,993.73 from the projected budget. Total income for this period is \$37,480.25 with expenses of \$41,858.94 with a difference of \$4378.69.

SPR: Debbie reported the hiring of Alayna Nelson and that she started on Monday August 5. Nursery-Pastor Sara had reported to the committee that Sandy Middleton has offered to handle the coordination of nursery staff and materials. Volunteers are still needed to allow for staffing of 2 vetted adults for each service. Pastor Sara and Pastor Byrce had provided their current objectives and overall status of things since Pastor Sara's arrival. There are currently two applications for the Leadership Team. Interviews will be discussed. Pastor Sara will coordinate with the applicants and the SPRC with schedule. Sub committees-the method for Leadership Teams subcommittees to provide a written report the the Leadership Team either by e-mail or before the meeting. Fall Kickoff discussion was held about including 50 year jubilee recognitions in the kickoff plans for Marilyn Spurrell and Elmer Brinkman. The next meeting for SPRC will be September 4 at 1:30 p.m.

Ministry: Barb reported that Thursday Night Live was not at good as they had hoped.

They were not in a very good spot with the booth. Also, possibly doing this on Kids Night next year and to have handouts of upcoming FUMC Events. The diaper give away was successful. The goad was met to have the ice cream floats. Months for the giveaways are October, January, April, and August. Set up packing sessions on a regular basis and Maybe have advertising out there to get the word out. Mission of the month (subject to revision) August is Shoebox Christmas, September Diaper Ministry, November Inter church mission Rachel's hope, December Alternative Gift Giving. Grow groups-to enrich our people, ideas for the grow groups plus volunteers, Homecoming station-3rd week of September to hand out freezes or hot chocolate or snacks. Suggestions such as tee shirts to wear during the event. Barb was asked about getting new folders for the music for the choir song books. It was decided to get them.

Closed with the Breakthrough Prayer.

Next meeting September 10th at 5:30 p.m. Meeting adjourned at 7:25pm. Devotion will be given by Barb.
