- Watertown Area People Against Child Hunger (PACH) assists children and youth enrolled in a school within Codington county, who may not have enough food to eat at home, by providing them with easy-to-prepare weekend meals and snacks throughout the year.
- The PACH program served an average 574 children a week with a total of 20,679 bags for the 2023-2024 school year.
- The Watertown Area PACH Program completes its mission with food donations, monetary donations and volunteer hours from the community.
