#### What is Holy Week?

On April 13<sup>th</sup>, we will kick-off Holy Week. Holy Week is the time of year that we remember the stories of Jesus in the week of his death and Resurrection.

We start with Palm Sunday – a day celebrating Jesus' entrance to Jerusalem, with the waving of palm branches and the celebration of the crowd. (Luke 19.28-40). Here at First Church – we will have palms to wave and celebrate during worship, a pancake breakfast and a bake sale.

Monday and Tuesday of Holy Week are the moments we remember the stories of Jesus teaching and leading within Jerusalem. On Monday we read the story

of Jesus' being anointed with oil (John 12.1-11) and on Tuesday Jesus teaches and reminds the disciples about his upcoming death. (John 12.20-36)

Wednesday of Holy Week is the day we hear of Jesus' betrayer. Jesus knew that Judas would betray him, and even spoke about it, giving him one last chance to change. (John 13.21-32). Here at First Church, the Wednesday of Holy Week will include the last Community Lenten Service at the UCC at 12:05pm. Our regular meal and music practices. The youth and children will have a Stations of the Cross event.

Thursday of Holy Week, or Maundy Thursday, is the night we remember the Last Supper. (John 13:1-17, 31b -35) Here at First Church, you are invited to a Dinner Church Worship Service in the Fellowship hall at 6:00 p.m.

Friday of Holy Week, or Good Friday, is the night we remember Jesus' death on the cross. (John 18.1-19.42). Our Good Friday Worship Service will be at 6:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary.

Saturday of Holy Week is a day of quiet grief. The disciples' grieving Jesus' death and not expecting the miracle to come, hide out in the upper room. (John 19:38-42) Here at First Church, however, our Saturday Worship Service will kick-off our Easter Celebrations at 5:00 p.m.

On Easter Sunday we will continue to celebrate the Risen Christ through worship, song and scripture. Join us at our regular Sunday Morning Worship, ready to sing and celebrate. (Matthew 28.1-10)

I know sometimes it can be tempting to go from the parade of Palm Sunday to the Joy of Easter morning, but the stories in between help us to remember the depth of Christ's sacrifice for us. In the darkest parts of our lives, God is there with us. So plug these extra services into your calendars and journey with us, through the uncertainties of Holy Week into the unending joy of Easter Morning.

#### LEADERSHIP TEAM MEETING

TUESDAY, MARCH 11, 2025, 5:30 PM

Members present: Peggy Lindahl, Pastor Sara, Sue Luken, April Geffre, Marcia Schneider, Sue Stern, Adam Fox, Josh Hartley

Members Absent: Pastor Bryce, Doug Wishard, Stephanie Long and Corrine Dahl

Devotion & Opening Prayer was given by Pastor Sara.

April opened the meeting at 5:35 p.m.

Accessibility Team Update: Pastor Sara reported that there has not been much action on the elevator. It was suggested to put a ramp up into the nursery that would get to office floor. Adam Fox reported on the security system proposals. He and Pastor Bryce were communicating on this. He had not heard from Pastor Bryce on a few of the questions he had. Reported on the cleaning of the bell tower. Lisa has reached out to Service Master again as the two quotes received were approximately \$10,000 difference.

It was brought to our attention that in order to add Sue Luken on the checking account as a signer that Danielle Mikkelson would have to be removed. The following resolution was passed by motion from Adam second by April, all aye: "The names of individuals on file for signatures on the First United Methodist Church bank account have been reviewed and should be changed as such: Erika Zink, Debbie Engels, Jerry Miller and Jeri Larson will remain as check signers. Danielle Mikkelson will be removed and Sue Luken will be added." Motion Passed.

#### **New Business:**

Music Team Discussion: Pastor Sara reported there are a few people that have shown interest in playing for the church services. Discussion of the service times was discussed with more discussion to follow next month.

Pastor Bryce report (sent to Pastor Sara); Fundraisers are going well. There will be a pancake breakfast on 4/13/25. Night out dinner was a success again this year. He will be preaching at the Weslyan Chapel on 3/27/25.

This years annual conference will be June 6, 7, and 8 in Mitchell. Ordination will take place on Sunday morning. Pastor Sara reported this may be live streamed and it will also be live streamed in our church for services. There are 6 Lay delegates for the Conference this year

along with the two pastors. Lay people that are interested in attending are Peggy Lindahl, Sue Luken, Marcia Schneider, Sue Stern, and April Geffre hopes to be able to attend.

Pastor Sara reported that Blair has agreed to help out with the music on Saturday nights and Sundays at 10:00. The 8:30 service needs someone to help out with the sound and live stream. Sara has also been working on Lent Study and services. She will be taking a couple of days off next week to spend them with her kids while they are on spring break.

Buildings and Grounds: Corrine Dahl, absent no report. Josh brought up the railing and door.

Finance: April reported the income for February was \$39,131.15 with expenses at \$41,111.96 for a loss of \$1,980.51.

There is a need to coordinate volunteer workers.

SPR: Sue Luken reported SPR met on March 5. Alayna Nelson has submitted her resignation from her position as Director of Worship and Discipleship. The meeting was centered around rewriting the position. It will become 2 part-time positions. Contemporary Worship Director and Media and Graphics Designer. Nursery Staff has been an ongoing concern. The Nursery Coordinator and Nursery Care Provider were also revised. The Dakota/Minnesota Conference is offering a virtual training on Thursday March 13 for SPR Committees. Sue, Peggy, Pastor Sara and Pastor Bryce will be attending.

Ministry: Marcia reported PACH packing will be 3/17 at 6:00 – 7:30. Prayer Walk was well received. There will be an Easter Outreach Event, on 4/26 from 10am-noon at the Auditorium trying to have a Cup Cake Walk, duck pond, ring toss; Diaper Giveaway on 5/7 from 4-6 p.m.

Peggy brought up the discussion on Inventory. Pastor Sara has named her as coordinator of this. She will be reaching out to Peggy to get this task taken care of.

Closed with the Breakthrough Prayer.

Next meeting April 8, 2025 at 5:30 p.m. Meeting adjourned. Devotion will be given by Sue Luken.


# **First Youth Snapshot:**
