Music plays an integral role in the mission of First United Methodist Church. The Contemporary Worship Director will help connect people to God through music and worship. The Contemporary Worship Director will lead the praise team and coordinate musicians.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A committed disciple of Jesus Christ.
- Have experience leading contemporary worship services.
- Have high energy, maturity, and leadership experience with the ability to connect with people of all ages, as well as empower volunteers.
- Possess a highly collaborative style and sincere commitment to work with all church groups including staff and volunteers
- Be a self-starter, able to work independently, and enjoy leading, creating, and implementing ideas as needed.
- Must pass a background check and follow the First United Methodist Church Safer Sanctuaries policies.

ACCOUNTABILITY: Reports to Senior Pastor and SPRC (Staff Parish Relations Committee). For the first year of employment, this position will be evaluated quarterly. After the first year of employment is completed, the position will be reviewed annually.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plan, lead music, and coordinate volunteers for the contemporary and blended services, ensuring vocals and accompaniment are present.
- Collaborate with Music Director in planning music for traditional and blended services to create cohesion between all worship services.
- Recruit, train, and equip volunteers to be involved in the weekend music teams.
- Recruit, train, and equip volunteers to fit well in the weekend tech teams
- Other leadership duties as deemed reasonable for the position.

Position is hourly, 10-15 hours per week. Hours are flexible but must include Saturdays 2pm-6pm, and Sundays 9:30 am-11 am.
