

<u>Our Mission</u>: Through compassion, respect, and collaboration, we strive to create a pathway out of homelessness, fostering hope and rebuilding lives within our community by providing safe, temporary housing and support to individuals and families.

<u>Our Services</u>: We offer temporary housing and case management to help our clients find permanent housing and meet other goals. Our staff and volunteers work tirelessly to ensure that each guest receives the personalized attention they need.

Our Needs: We rely on the support of our community to keep Watertown Cares running smoothly. We have a variety of volunteer opportunities available, from shoveling snow to teaching classes. Join us in making a difference in the lives of those in need.

<u>Vision Statement</u>: To create a community where every individual and family has access to safe, stable housing and the resources necessary to thrive, free from the cycle of homelessness.

612 Flats: The 612 Flats have eight units to house community members who currently do not have permanent housing. The funding is provided through a grant for emergency housing and administered by Watertown Cares.


