The gift boxes are for infant and toddlers to 17 year olds. All gifts must be able to fit inside a shoebox.


A collection box will be at the back of the sanctuary throughout the month of August. Please help us fill it to overflowing.



#### **VBS RECAP**

Our first night of VBS was full of energy, joy, and a powerful reminder of how God can use ordinary people to do extraordinary things! We explored the story of Tabitha— a woman known for her gift of kindness, generosity, and service to others.

Night 2 of VBS was all about trusting God with the gifts He gives us! We dove into the Parable of the Talents, where Jesus teaches us that everyone has been given something valuable—and God wants us to use those gifts wisely and faithfully.

Night 3 of VBS was a powerful reminder that no giant is too big when God is on our side! We explored the well-loved story of David and Goliath, where a young shepherd showed his gift of incredible courage and faith to stand up against a mighty warrior.

Our final night of VBS was a beautiful celebration of everything we've learned this week! We focused on the truth that God gives each of us unique gifts and abilities, and they all matter in His Kingdom.

Throughout the week, our VBS attendees stayed focused and committed to our mission project supporting **Sandy's Closet.** And wow—did they deliver!

By the end of the week, our kids and families collected an **amazing 719 items of clothing**, and a generous anonymous community member added **another 336 items**, bringing our total to an incredible **1,055 clothing items** donated! But the giving didn't stop there. In addition to the clothing drive, the children and families also **raised nearly \$750** in donations to support Sandy's Closet.

This week, our VBS kids didn't just learn about God's love—they **lived it**. Their compassion, generosity, and commitment were a true reflection of Christ's heart in action.


