**Devotion & Opening Prayer** was given by Pastor Sara. Prayer for Sue Stern for her husband. Prayed the Breakthrough Prayer with edits that were done.

### **Pastor Updates:**

Pastor Sara is now officially off the Board of Ordained Ministry. She and Pastor Kim went to Lake Poinsett for long term planning. Going well with the makeup of staff.

Pastor Kim is working on discipleship where people are and their wants. Working on care and staying connected. Working on future planning.

Amy is working on Confirmation. Bible Study started Saturday. Cady is running the Bible Study. Looking for Mentors.

### **Building and Grounds:**

Josh reported roof vent is getting old. The downstairs AC Unit is done. The thermostat might need to be replaced.

Bell Tower: Received a quote from ServPro. Service Master didn't respond with the phone calls from Pastor Sara. After a short discussion Peggy made a motion to approve ServPro's estimate for the job. Stephanie Long second the motion. All ave.

Snow removal contract is in for the 2026-2027 winter. The contract is from Stadheim Contractors. The prices have gone up. Parking Lot \$120-\$150, Sidewalks \$45 per person, Salt \$30; Haul snow \$125. This will be a 3 year contract effective through May 1, 2029. Stephanie moved to accept the contract. Josh second the motion. All aye.

The closets and classrooms are getting organized. Some need to be finished.

### Finance:

We are in the black this month as far as our giving. Pastor Sara reported total income for the month was \$36,057.99. Total expenses was \$34,446.63 for a difference of \$1,611.36. The budget needs to be worked on.

The full umbrella insurance has gone up from \$27,516 to \$30,379 annually. This includes Workman's Comp, building and contents.

### Staff Parish Relations Committee:

Sue Luken reported we did not have a need to meet. She mentioned that there was an article on Pastor Sara in the Dakota UMC newsletter and her time as Registrar. She has held that position for the last six years. The SPRC will be holding a joint meeting with SPR from Clark on 9/29/25 at 5:30 pm. There is a need for people on Leadership Team. Please contact Pastor Sara if you are interested.

### **Ministry:**

Marcia reported Watertown Banquet served about 130 people. Thursday Night Live needs signage and have a night when kids will be present. No requests from Rachel's Hope. The Diaper Ministry will be the mission of the month for September. The Diaper sorting will be October 7<sup>th</sup> 4:30 pm to 6:30 pm The diaper giveaway and Sandy's Closet will be October 27<sup>th</sup>. Trunk or Treat will be the 29<sup>th</sup> of October. Out Reach will give \$1000 for diapers. October's mission of the month will be Beacon Center.

Peggy spoke with Blair about doing the music inventory. He will contact Michael and get back to her on when we can get together to start the inventory.

Fall Kick Off begins tomorrow evening. The movie has been moved inside as the bees have moved in.

Josh will be absent for the October meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.

We will then do a fun activity during the Children's Message that day with their Bibles




