Greetings friends,

As we continue into our 2<sup>nd</sup> month of the year, we begin to look forward to Lent. Lent is the time of year in which we turn our hearts toward Jesus and his journey to the cross. Often Lent is a time of year for renewed spiritual practices.

Some take the time to fast, or to refrain, from something. We can decide to refrain from specific foods, such as meat or sugar, or an entire meal altogether. Some folks fast from purchases or specific activities. Maybe it's fasting from snap judgements or prejudice.

For others, Lent is a time of addition. We add spiritual practices like prayer or devotion. Some might join a Bible Study or a small group. Maybe it's a spiritual practice of watching the news or listening to other's stories.

Regardless of what we do – Lent is an opportunity to focus our hearts on God. To learn from Jesus' life and teachings, to hear God's message for us, to look into our selves and reflect on our sin and to work towards repentance. For many years, my Lenten Spiritual Practice has been to wear a clergy collar, a visible reminder to myself of who I am in Christ. You may see me begin early this year, as Bishop Plambeck has asked us to be more visible in our communities.

The journeys we all take in life and specifically in Lent are important reminders of God's presence alongside us. Even as the stories of Jesus teach us to grow in ways we've never imagined.

Our worship will focus on the ways that God moves – the transitions from place to place, like Jesus headed into the desert – the challenges away from our comfort zones – like Jesus when confronted by strangers - and even as Jesus moves toward the cross.

Lent begins with our Ash Wednesday worship at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday February 18<sup>th</sup>.

This Lent friends, let us move with Christ!

**LEADERSHIP TEAM MINUTES—TUESDAY, JANUARY 20, 2026—5:30 PM**

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Adam Fox, Josh Hartley, April Noem, Sue Luken, Marcia Schneider, Heidi Steffensen, Pastor Sara, Pastor Kim

**DEVOTIONS AND PRAYER:** Marcia Schneider shared a devotion with a theme of JOY.

**AGENDA:**

**ACCESSIBILITY TEAM UPDATE:** Town Hall meetings were held following each worship service last weekend. The accessibility team narrowed the choices to 2 options plus a 3<sup>rd</sup> option of "do nothing". These were presented including the changes, pros and cons of each plan and the estimated cost. A handout was given asking people to pray about this. Church members are to complete a survey indicating which plan the church should pursue.

Grant options: Information about a grant was given. This grant is for churches of historical significance in their community to improve the accessibility to the building. This grant is for up to \$500,000. Pastor Sara will be follow-up on this.

**BELL TOWER:** There is work that needs to be done in the bell tower. The screening needs to be fixed soon. The walkways need to be reinforced. A sturdy ladder needs to be acquired to gain entrance to the bell tower.

**CLOSET/CLASSROOM REPAIRS AFTER THE WATER DAMAGE:** Damage was done to several areas of the church following the water which infiltrated the building last December. Following is a list of needed repairs: Confirmation classroom – ceiling & plaster; chapel and music room – ceiling tile and cracks; closet in cry room – much damage; pie room – ceiling damage.

**PASTOR UPDATES:**

Pastor Sara: Last week she was on vacation. She and Pearl have been working on end of the year paperwork. Pastor Sara & Pastor Kim will be attending the Bishop's Epiphany Gathering in Aberdeen February 8-10. April has been hired as youth leader for middle school and high school youth group. Pastor Amy's responsibility will be confirmation.

Pastor Kim: For worship planning, she will be using the same sermon series in Clark as in Watertown. She coordinates home communion and the memory care services. She is working on the devotion page that is included in the weekly bulletin. A ministry team member will be attending the next church Foundation meeting to talk about Stable Blessings.

**LEADERSHIP TEAM GROUP UPDATES:**

Building & Grounds - Josh: The water damage is the biggest concern. The duct work on the AC unit on the roof over Cook Hall will be completed in the spring.

Finance – April Noem: Giving is going in the right direction.

*Generosity Grove:* This is a pilot program from the conference designed to help us as a church tell our story.

SPR – Sue Luken: Things have been pretty quiet since our November LT meeting. We appreciate Pastor Kim helping with the 7:00 Christmas Eve service. LT interviews – we want to welcome Heidi Steffensen, Allen Stern, & Lisa Stydel to Leadership Team. There was a joint SPR meeting with Clark in December. Strengths we see with the arrangement of sharing Pastor Kim are the open communication and the flexibility of both churches.

Ministry – Marcia Schneider: Curious Creation for this quarter will be Saturday, February 21 after worship. This will begin with devotion based on JOY. The activity will be dance. Stable Blessing bags have been distributed to 212 Flats, Salvation Army, Beacon Center, and to some persons who have stopped by the church.

OTHER: April shared that because she is now on staff, she will be leaving the Leadership Team. At our February meeting, we will need to select a chairperson, vice-chair, and secretary.

Meeting concluded with the *Breakthrough Prayer*.

Next meeting: The next meeting will be February 10, 2026 at 5:30. Devotions will be by Adam.



3. Internal Changes with offices and reception for better security.




### Pros

### Cons


1. The use of lifts still makes people nervous

3. Add accessible toilets in Sanctuary.
4. Add ramps through current nursery space and rearrange internally.
5. Add lift into Cook Hall from Fellowship Hall.




### Pros
